Level 1 Introduction to Food Safety in Catering

This qualification is intended for people starting to work in the catering industry. It will give basic information for people serving but NOT preparing food. People preparing food should have at least a level 2 qualification designed for their role.

The 1st Line Training introduction to Food Safety in Catering is certified by 1st Line Training, but still presented to the high standards demanded by our regulators.

How long will it take me to achieve this qualification?

The total qualification time for this qualification is 4 hours, all of which are recommended as guided learning hours.

How is the qualification assessed?

This qualification is assessed by multiple-choice examination.
